WELCOME TO THE TUTORIAL

This tutorial teaches you how to take your test on the computer. It talks about how to use your mouse.

This tutorial also gives you some practice verbal items to try. You will have the chance to try some practice math items in another tutorial that will be shown later.

If you don't understand something, raise your hand and someone in charge will help you.

You have 20 minutes to finish this tutorial.

Please take a moment to check your test station to make sure you have some scrap paper and a pencil to use for this test. If you do not have scrap paper, please raise your hand now to get some scrap paper and a pencil.

Use your mouse and click on the "Next" box in the lower-right hand corner of the screen. Please raise your hand now if you cannot do this.

The PREVIOUS button allows you to move backwards in the test. The responses you have recorded to the current task are saved. Using the mouse, click on the PREVIOUS button.

Click the NEXT button to continue.



Your test will have two parts:

Part I - Verbal

Part II - Math

You will have 22 minutes to complete each part. While you are working on each part, the amount of time you have left will be shown in the bottom left-hand corner of the screen where the red arrow is pointing. Right now, the time shown is the amount of time you have left to work on this autorial.

You must take a 10 minute break between the verbal and math parts.

Click Next to continue.



Because this is a timed test, it is important not to spend too much time on ary one question. If you get stuck on a problem, you must guess and move on.

Work carefully and try to answer as many questions as you can. Do not worry if you don't finish all the questions. You are not expected to know every answer

Click Next to continue.
